PROCEDURAL INSTRUCTIONS (for information only – **DELETE THIS PAGE when finalizing the document):**

The designated election official, if instructed by resolution of the governing body either before or after the 63rd day before the election, shall cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected.

This Notice of Cancellation is to be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the special district; and is to be posted at each polling place, in the office of the designated election official, and in the office of the county clerk and recorder of each county in which the special district is located.

The Notice of Cancellation must also be filed with the Division of Local Government through the E-Filing Portal.

The governing body shall notify the candidates that the election was canceled and that they were elected by acclamation.
